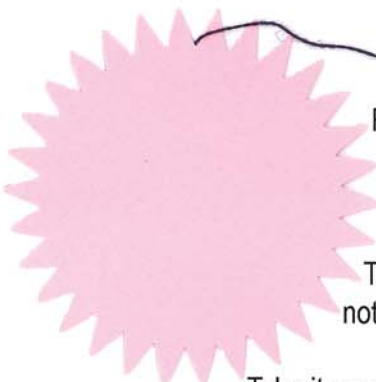
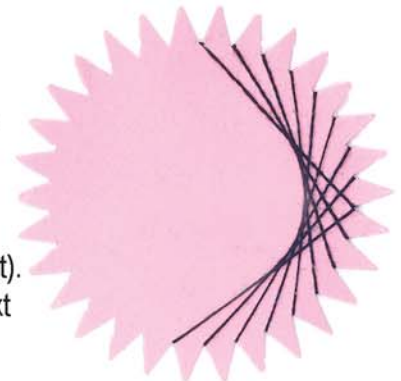


Basic Supplies  
Cardstock weight paper, Spirelli shapes and thread

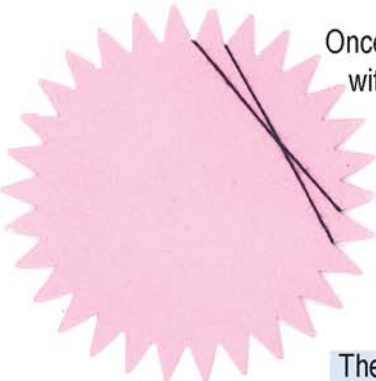


You can use any type of embroidery or craft thread. First fasten the end of the thread securely to the back of your shape with a small piece of tape.

Direct the thread through one of the notches (back to front). Then wind the thread over the front of the shape to the next notch in the pattern.

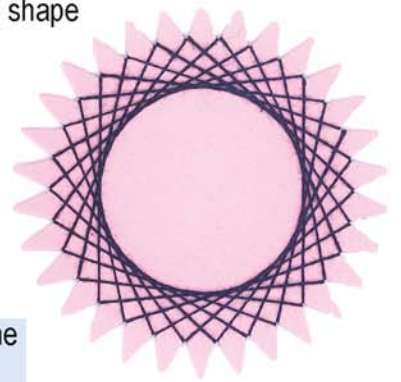


Take it around to the back of the shape, and then to the front again through the next notch. Follow the pattern, working clockwise, until the circle has been completed (ending at your first notch).



Once complete, cut the thread and secure it to the back of the shape with another piece of tape.

Your freshly made Spirelli shape is now ready to become the main feature of an artful greeting card.



The number of notches you skip with each wrap will determine the size of the hole in the center of the finished piece. The more notches you skip, the smaller the hole will be.
